

## **COURSE OUTLINE**

This 5-day course is nationally accredited by Family Planning Alliance Australia (FPAA) and has standardised assessment.

The course is recognised by the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) & Australian College of Rural & Remote Medicine (ACRRM) for all medical practitioners wanting to increase their knowledge base and clinical skills in SRH. (RACGP 40 points/ ACRRM 30 points)

### **Part 1 Theory Course**

**Date:** 21<sup>st</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> October 2019

**Cost:** \$2,000

Includes handbooks:

- Reproductive & Sexual Health: An Australian Clinical Practice Handbook 3<sup>rd</sup> ed (FPNSW)
- Contraception: An Australian Clinical Practice Handbook 4<sup>th</sup> ed (FPAA)

**Part 2 Clinical Training** involves minimum of 7 x 3-hour clinics

**Cost:** \$180 per clinic (including GST)

Extra sessions by negotiation.

## **Part One: THEORY COURSE**

Theory component consists of 5 consecutive days and includes:

- Extensive contraception sessions (ImplanonNXT training - TBC)
- Sexually transmissible infections and blood borne viruses
- Women's Reproductive & Sexual Health (RSH)
- Men's Reproductive & Sexual Health
- Cultural issues related to RSH
- Disability & RSH
- Sexual violence
- Sexual and gender diversity
- Pregnancy options
- Working with young people

### **ASSESSMENT**

The Short Answer and Role Play assessments are held on Friday. This allows completion of all segments of the theoretical course during the workshop.

## **Part Two: CLINICAL TRAINING**

Clinical placement training provides the opportunity for participants to develop and apply their theoretical knowledge, practice skills, gain confidence, develop counselling and communication skills whilst under direct clinical supervision

- Clinical instruction involves 7 - 10 x 3-hour clinics. Should the experienced FPWNT trainer consider that more training is required, further clinics will be negotiated and the cost revised.

### **TRAINING CRITERIA**

- A separate clinical application form must be completed.
- Participants must provide photo identification. They must be qualified medical practitioners registered to practise in Australia, and members of a medical defence organisation. They must have a current NT Working with Children (Ochre) Card.

### **ASSESSMENT**

Assessment of the clinical training is by continuous assessment and completion of a clinical practice portfolio.

## **CERTIFICATE**

The full national *Certificate in Reproductive and Sexual Health* is awarded on completion of both theoretical and clinical aspects of the course.
