Topics covered will include genitourinary health, contraception, safe circumcisions, sexual behavior, cultural beliefs in regard to sex, sexual history taking, sexually transmitted infections, sexual and domestic violence, pregnancy education and sexual health promotion and education.

The course is open to all registered Aboriginal Health Workers, students currently undertaking studies in the Certificate IV in Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care and Community Health Workers.
