GENERAL INFORMATION

Family Planning Welfare Association of NT Inc. (FPWNT) delivers a comprehensive Well Women's Health Screening training program incorporating an accredited unit of the Certificate IV in Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care (HLTAHW414A).

The unit is open to all Health Practitioners and aims at providing participants with a broad knowledge of relevant sexual health information as well as skills necessary to undertake sexual health promotion including pap provision in their own workplace and community.

The training is divided into two components: a theoretical component delivered over a three day period, and a two day clinical component involving direct supervised clinical training.

To achieve competency participants will be required to complete:

- A written assessment
- A health promotion activity (theoretical)
- Demonstrate clinical competency under direct/indirect supervision in attending to 15 Well Women's Health Screenings (3 completed within the training time and 12 to be completed in the workplace)
- Sexual history taking skills demonstration

UNIT OUTLINE

Theory Component:

The theory component is delivered over 3 consecutive days and will provide participants with advanced knowledge and skills in the area of womens sexual health and sexual health promotion.

Topics covered will include:

- Contraception choices
- Cervical screening
- Breast awareness
- Sexual behaviour and values
- Sexually transmitted infections
- Sexual and domestic violence
- Pregnancy education
- Health promotion
- Menopause
- Sexual History taking

Clinical Component:

The clinical component is held on day 4 and 5 following the Theory component.

Further clinical training will be required in the workplace with ongoing support from your workplace assessor and your regional Well Women's Health Educator.

If you require further clinical training at FPWNT clinics additional cost will be incurred.

UNIT FEES: \$1296

Note: Northern Territory Department of Health (DoH) support their employees by funding FPWNT to deliver a number of courses each year across the Northern Territory. Contact your regional Well Women's Health Educator to apply.
