To attend the clinics

- You do not need a referral
- Bookings are essential Monday-Friday and clinics are usually booked in advance
- Most appointments are 20 minutes long. We will ask what you are coming in for and longer appointment times will be given if required
- Consultations are private and confidential
- Some contraception and certain medications are available on the premises
- Training of nurses and doctors is one of our major roles. As a client, you may be asked if a trainee can observe your consultation or if you would like a chaperone
- Clinics available at Coconut Grove & Palmerston

Cost of consult

- Consultations are FREE (bulk billed) if you are in the medicare system
- If you are not in the medicare system there will be a charge of \$80-\$200 for your consult, with extra charges for pathology and medication
